

Wine Type	Description	Time from Making to Bottling	Price per batch (27-30 bottles)
Argentinean Malbec	This wine, which is full-bodied, richly dry and a deep garnet color, has a long, lingering finish. It has a foundation of Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes from the Veneto region. Notes of plum, sour cherry, raspberry and vanilla gradually marry with anise, bitter chocolate, coffee and fig tones that develop with age. Its depth, which is likened to Port (without the sweetness), comes from the addition of dried grapes during fermentation.	6 weeks	\$190
Australian Chardonnay	This grape was recently introduced into Australia, producing a wine that is rich in character, with an emphasis on fruit. A golden-hued wine, it will have a tart taste that finishes clean and crisp in the mouth. Flavors of vanilla, cloves and butterscotch will tease the palate.	6 weeks	\$170
Australian Shiraz	This dry red is deep and dark in color with a rich bouquet of fruit that ages gracefully into a velvety wine of pure elegance. You'll want heavy oaking in this full-bodied red wine from Australia!	6 weeks	\$170
Beaujolais	This popular, fine French-style wine is a light, slightly fruity, very pleasing red which can be served at room temperature or slightly chilled. This wine can be enjoyed on any occasion and doesn't need much aging.	4 weeks	\$140
Bella Bianco	This white wine has extraordinarily rich, buttery aromas and flavors that are balanced by lush, tropical fruit and nice oak character.	6 weeks	\$160
Champagne	A fantastic bubbly made from a blend of quality California grape varietals. This off-dry sparkling wine has a fruity bouquet and taste, with a crisp finish and light gold color. It has a wonderful balance of fruit and acidity--just what you'd expect from a fine, sparkling wine!	5 weeks	\$160
Chateauneuf-de-Pape	Made with a blend of varietal grapes, this concentrate produces a richly satisfying red wine. Its medium-bodied flavor is fruity and spicy, with a full oak finish. Aromas of ripe cherries and blackberries abound. Chateauneuf-du-Pape is translated as "the Pope's new castle."	6 weeks	\$160

Chianti	Originally from the Chianti region in Italy, this California blend makes a wine that has a bright ruby color and a fruity, tannic flavor with oak accents. It is great young but does improve with short-term aging.	4 weeks	\$140
French Vigonier	The intense fruitiness of this beguiling wine suggests rich sweetness, but it shows a surprisingly dry and aromatic finish. A delicate yellow color, tinged with the variety's typical 'green-gold' hue, it bursts out of the glass with apricot, peach and spice aromas. As it matures, it can also display hints of jasmine, honeysuckle, kiwi, mint, orange blossom and even mango! While higher in alcohol than many white wines, it drinks well young nonetheless.	6 weeks	\$170
Granny Smith's Riesling	Hints of fresh apple underscore the pleasant fruity notes that are one of Riesling's delightful trademarks. Clean, cool and crisp - a wonderful balance of sweetness with the slight acidity and firm character of the Riesling grape.	4 weeks	\$140
Gruner Veltliner	Pleasant aromas reminiscent of apple, pear, grapefruit and melon fill the senses and the flavors echo these complex aromas. This medium bodied wine shows a touch of sweetness that is perfectly balanced with the natural acidity. A versatile food wine and a great alternative to Chardonnay.	6 weeks	\$170
Ice Wine	This dessert wine, based on Riesling grapes, will surprise you with its body and complexity. Rich and viscous, it's loaded with flavors of honey, peach and apricot. Sip this golden nectar slowly to appreciate it fully!	4 weeks	\$140
Italian Amarone	This red has a dark, dense structure and lush flavors of ripe cherry, black currant and blackberry. Watch for subtle notes of clove, vanilla and oak with a background suggestive of earthiness.	6 weeks	\$190
Italian Pinot Grigio	This elegant and subtle varietal from Italy has a light golden hue and medium body. The exquisite balance of citrus fruit and acidity gives a refreshing crisp quality and a hint of spice.	6 weeks	\$170
Merlot	Premium Varietal Juice fermented with Crushed Grape Skins. A rich aroma of red cherries and toasted oak. Expressive flavors of dark ripe plums, berries and silky tannins in this medium bodied red.	6 weeks	\$190

New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc	This white wine is crisp and light, with intense flavors of grapefruit peel and freshly cut grass. It has a soft, lightly golden hue, (with a slight tinge of green) and an accent of light oak on the finish.	6 weeks	\$170
Pinot Chardonnay	The best dry white wines of California are made from the Pinot Chardonnay grape. They are best when made dry, with a hint of oak. A light apple and creamy flavor may be evident. This wine finishes a bit less dry than our 6 wk. Chardonnay.	4 weeks	\$140
Pinot Grigio	A favorite white wine that is made from a grape with light acidity. Its color is like pale straw and its fragrance is delicate. It is dry, with overtones of green melon, leading to a crisp, clean finish.	4 weeks	\$140
Pinot Noir	Recognized as a premier grape growing region, California is known for intensely flavorful Pinot Noirs. Medium to full-bodied, this wine presents a bouquet of rich tobacco, ripe blackberries and spices. The palate is treated to a heady experience of dark cherries, a hint of oak and velvety tannins.	6 weeks	\$160
Pinotage	Created in South Africa by crossing Burgundy's Pinot Noir and Rhone's Cinsault grape, this juice comes from a certified organic vineyard. Flavors are complex with dominant currant, cherry, banana, blackberry, vanilla & toastiness, thanks to two stage oak aging. (French oak during fermentation, Hungarian oak for next 5 weeks)	6 weeks	\$190
Rosso Grande	An intense wine, it boasts a deep ruby-garnet color and spicy oak aroma. Bursting with vibrant flavors of ripe berries and black cherries, Rosso Grande is a dry, powerful wine with finesse and elegance.	6 weeks	\$160
Shiraz	Premium Varietal Juice fermented with Crushed Grape Skins. Bold and assertive. The aroma of black currants and toasted oak gives way to a flavor with overtones of chocolate, pepper spice and chewy tannins.	6 weeks	\$190
Super Tuscan	Our gold medal winner made from Cabernet, Merlot and Sangiovese grapes. A big, full-bodied wine with solid structure and bold fruit notes. Hints of cassis, plum and cherry balance the bold tannins of this hearty red. French and American oak contribute toasty vanilla flavors and rich complexity.	6 weeks	\$190

White Zinfandel	California's Zinfandel grapes are used to make this blush wine by pressing them as soon as they are picked and removing the thick skins from the vat immediately to minimize coloration. Served quite cold, this wine with a fruity aroma and taste is slightly sweet, soft and refreshing.	4 weeks	\$140
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
